LAKE YAHOU PARK frequently asked questions

WHEN IS THE PARK OPEN?

The park is open 7 days a week, with seasonal hours. Between October and March, Lake Yahou Park is open 6 AM - 5 PM; between April and September, it is open 6 AM - 7:30 PM.

DO I HAVE TO PAY TO USE THE PARK?

The park is free for all visitors; however visitors are required to purcha

The park is free for all visitors; however, visitors are required to purchase a \$5 MDA fishing license to fish in the lake.

- WHERE CAN I GET MY FISHING LICENSE?

 Licenses can be purchased at the MDA Office at 4975 Bains Gap Rd, with a valid driver's license.
- IS A STATE FISHING LICENSE REQUIRED?

 No, the MDA owns the property and has opened it to the community.
- DO MY KIDS / GRANDKIDS NEED FISHING LICENSES?

 Anyone under the age of 16 only needs to be accompanied by someone with an MDA fishing license in order to fish at Lake Yahou Park.
- CAN I BUY A FISHING LICENSE FOR SOMEONE ELSE?

 No, all MDA fishing licenses require an in-person signature from the licensee.
- WHAT PAYMENT METHODS ARE ACCEPTED?
 At this time, we only accept cash.
- ARE TROLLING MOTORS ALLOWED IN THE LAKE?

 No, no motorized water vehicles are allowed in the water.
- ARE THERE ANY PLANS TO RESTORE REILLY LAKE?

 At this time, there are no plans for Reilly Lake.
- WHO DO I CONTACT ABOUT PARK / TRAIL MAINTENANCE?
 For maintenance and clean-up, call the MDA at (256) 236-2011.
