frequently asked questions

WHEN IS THE PARK OPEN?

The park is open 7 days a week, with seasonal hours. Between October and March, Lake Yahu Park is open 6 AM - 5 PM; between April and September, it is open 6 AM - 7:30 PM.

DO I HAVE TO PAY TO USE THE PARK?

The park is free for all visitors; however, visitors are required to purchase a \$5 MDA fishing license to fish in the lake.

WHERE CAN I GET MY FISHING LICENSE?

Licenses can be purchased at the MDA Office at 4975 Bains Gap Rd, with a valid driver's license.

IS A STATE FISHING LICENSE REQUIRED?

No, the MDA owns the property and has opened it to the community.

DO MY KIDS / GRANDKIDS NEED FISHING LICENSES?

Anyone under the age of 16 only needs to be accompanied by someone with an MDA fishing license in order to fish at Lake Yahu Park.

CAN I BUY A FISHING LICENSE FOR SOMEONE ELSE?

No, all MDA fishing licenses require an in-person signature from the licensee.

WHAT PAYMENT METHODS ARE ACCEPTED?

At this time, we only accept cash.

ARE TROLLING MOTORS ALLOWED IN THE LAKE?

No, no motorized water vehicles are allowed in the water.

ARE THERE ANY PLANS TO RESTORE REILLY LAKE?

At this time, there are no plans for Reilly Lake.
